

# **Cookie Policy**

When you first enter our site, you can choose to accept all cookies or choose which are stored on your device using our cookie notice.

### Introduction

In order for our site to operate correctly, and to allow us to monitor its performance, we sometimes need to collect non-personally identifiable information about you which is collected in the form of cookies. We explain below what cookies are and and what types of cookie we use on our website.

#### What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. The information below explains the categories of cookies we use and why.

### Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary for you to use our website and cannot be switched off. They are usually set by actions you take such as creating privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but if you do this, some parts of our site will not work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

#### Performance cookies

These cookies let us look at numbers of visitors to our site, which pages are the most and least popular and understand how visitors move around the site. The information collected by these cookies is always anonymous. Performance cookies help us to improve the performance of our site. If you choose to block them, we will not know when you have visited our site, and will not be able to monitor its performance.

#### **Functional cookies**

Functional cookies remember preferences set by visitors and allow us to offer enhanced functionality, such as personalisation. These cookies may be set by us or by third party providers. If you choose to block these cookies, then some, or all, of this functionality may not work properly.

## **Targeting cookies**

These cookies are set by third party providers such as YouTube, Facebook and Twitter whose services we may link to on our website. If you reject these cookies, information cannot be collected by these third-party providers.

Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings.
