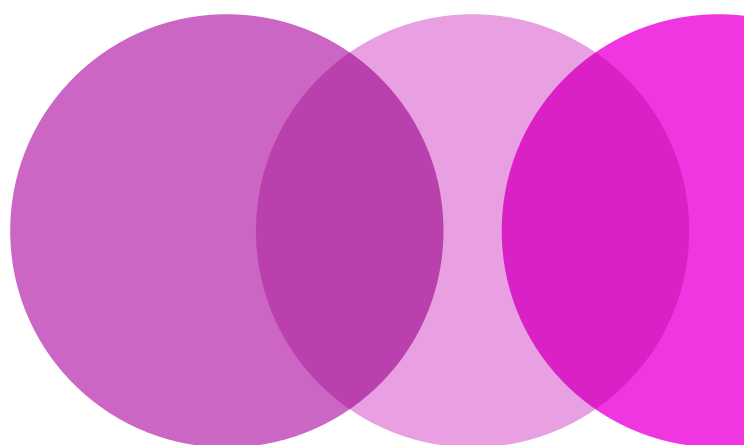

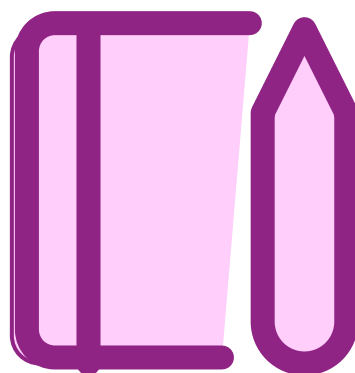

Strengthening public protection

The programme continued to focus on public confidence, safe practice and proportionate oversight for health and care roles not regulated by law. The revised Standards, published in March 2026 and due to take effect for Accredited Registers from 1 July 2026, provide a clearer framework for governance, safeguarding, professional suitability, collaboration and complaints handling.

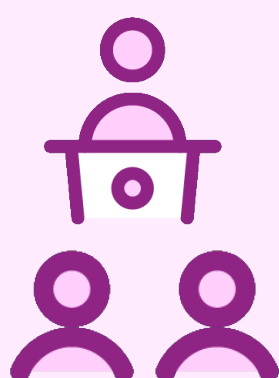
